PICKLE DIP

1 (8oz) container sour cream

1 cup finely chopped dill pickles

1 tablespoon garlic powder

1/4 cup dill pickle juice, or to taste

1 (8 oz) package cream cheese, softened

1 tablespoon Worcestershire sauce

1 tablespoon dill weed

Mix sour cream, cream cheese, pickles, Worcestershire sauce, garlic powder and dill together in a bowl until combines well. Stir in pickle juice to taste. Serve with chips and enjoy!!

Tips: add chopped green chile peppers for a spicy pickle dip.

PEANUT BUTTER SHEET CAKE

2 c flour 1/2 c oil

2 c sugar 1 stick margarine 1 tsp. baking soda 1/2 c peanut butter

1 c water 2 eggs

1tsp vanilla 1/2 c buttermilk

Mix dry ingredients together. Boil oil, margarine, peanut butter and water for 1 minute. Add dry ingredients. Stie in buttermilk, vanilla and eggs. Pour in jelly roll pan and bake at 350 degrees for 15 to 20 minutes.

ICING:

1/2 c peanut butter

1/3 c milk

1 stick margarine

1 tsp vanilla

2 2/3 c powdered sugar

Boil peanut butter, milk and margarine for 1 minute. Remove from heat and add vanilla and powdered sugar. Beat well. Spread icing over hot cake.
